

## Bedford Drive Primary School 2016-17

### Early Years Foundation Stage(EYFS)

60% of children achieved a Good Level of Development(GLD) (National 69% 2016)

### Phonics Screening

92% of the children in Year 1 met the expected standard in the Phonics Screening Check (National 81% 2016)

93% of the children retested in Year 2 met the expected standard in the Phonics Screening Check (National 91% 2016)

At Key Stage 1 Teacher Assessment is undertaken alongside national tests to build a picture of attainment. These judgements are moderated. The assessments in 2016 cannot be compared to previous assessments due to the change in curriculum.

Children sitting the Key Stage 2 tests this year were the second cohort to be taught and assessed under the new national curriculum.  
Expected standard has been raised with new national curriculum.

Progress – This will be updated after September 1<sup>st</sup> when progress is issued by DFE

This year there is also a change in the way progress is calculated. A school achieves sufficient progress scores in **all three subjects** reading, writing and mathematics if the average progress scores of Year 6 pupils are at least **-5** in English reading, **-5** in mathematics and **-7** in writing. At Bedford Drive the progress scores do not differ significantly from national as they are within the confidence interval.
